

Woven Quilt

Fabric:

To achieve the woven look of this quilt, choose fabrics that are distinct from each other. You will have one set of blocks oriented right and left and another oriented up and down. They will each have a main color and side strips.

For each main color, you need 13 inches.

For each side color, you need 8 inches.

9" blocks (finished size)

16 blocks for a wheel chair or NICU quilt.

Each block has:

2 side pieces 2 x 9.5

1 middle piece 6.5 x 9.5

Main colors:

Cut two strips 6.5 x wof from each fabric that will be the middle of the blocks. (4 strips) Cut off a tiny bit at the fold. (8 half strips)

Side pieces:

Cut 4 strips 2 x wof from each fabric that will be the edges of each block. (8 strips) Cut off a tiny bit at the fold. (16 half strips)

Sew one side strip to each edge of the wide strips. (8 strips)

Cut each strip into two 9.5" blocks. (16 blocks)

Sew the blocks together alternating colors and direction.
