

Postage Stamps and HSTs 32" Quilt

Fabric:

5 postage stamp blocks.
4 half postage stamp blocks
4 postage stamp 4-patches
(8 total postage stamp blocks or kits)

10 inches of each of two different fabrics.

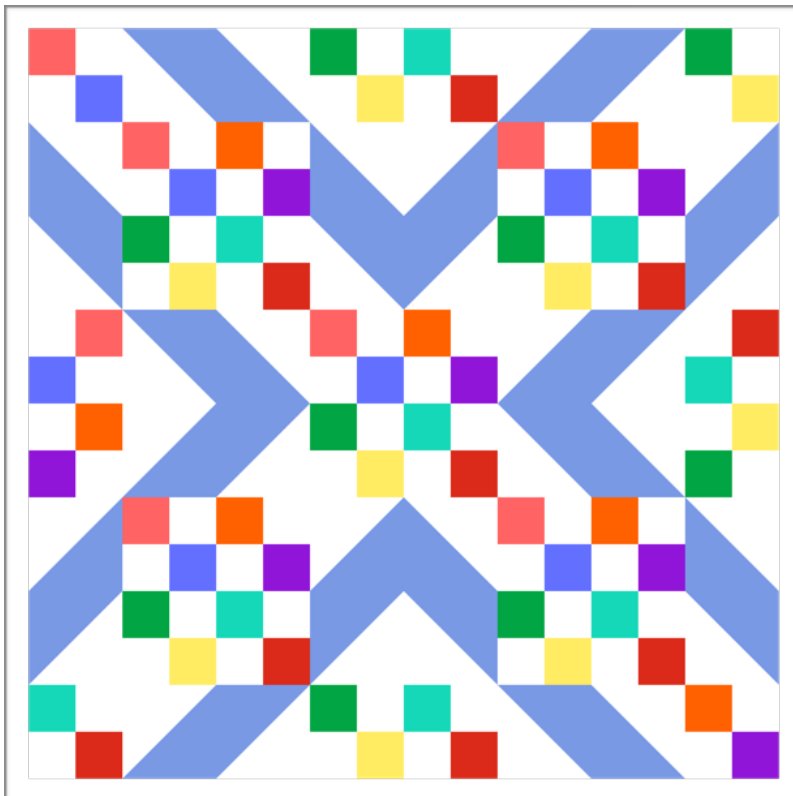
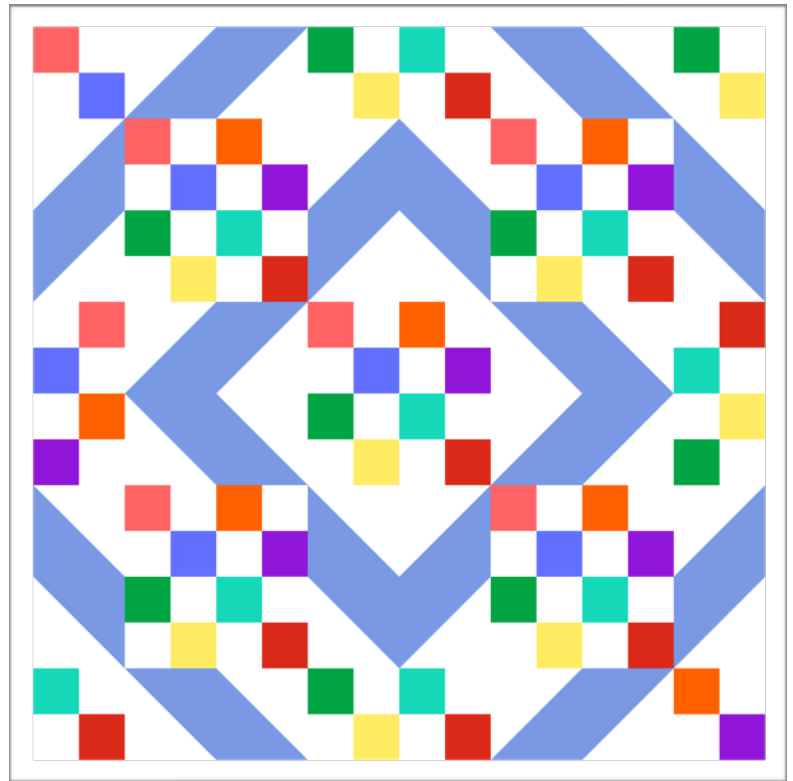
Cut:

Assuming the postage stamp blocks are already cut and made.

For the HSTs, out of both fabrics, cut two strips $4 \frac{7}{8}$ " wide. Then cut those strips into squares $4 \frac{7}{8}$ ".

Sew

Mark the diagonals on the back of all the one color of hst squares. Place right



sides together and sew two different colored squares $\frac{1}{4}$ inch either side of the mark. Cut them apart on the mark.

Sew HSTs together so the one color makes a parallelogram. Half will go one way and half another. Lay them out to match the picture.
