

Hello [REDACTED],

Thank you for working on the Quiltcon 2017 Charity Challenge quilt! I really appreciate your willingness to work with my design and my directions.

The directions include: a list of pieces needed from each fabric, a set of cutting directions for each piece, and sewing directions.

"Wof" means selvedge to selvedge width of fabric.

When I write "finished" size that means the size of the rectangle or square without seam allowances. The directions for cutting should already have .5 inches added to each dimension. I write down both so I can double check my math as I cut things out.

I cut the fabric amounts for your kits at the last meeting and I really hope that I gave you the right amounts. I just had a rough estimate at the time. Let me know if you have and questions.

Blue Strip Section

Blue background:
strip is 1.25 finished.

Cut 3 width of fabric strips 1.75" wide. Remove the selvedges and sew together to make an 80.5 inch strip. (It may only take two strips. not sure how wide the fabric really is.)

Pink: your kit should have a 3" pink square

Lt Blue:
strip is 3.75 finished.

Cut 2 width of fabric strips 4.25" wide. Remove selvedges and sew together to make a 75.5 inch strip.

Cut a rectangle 4.25 X 3.

Cut a rectangle 3 X 1.75.

Sew the small blue rectangle to the right side of the pink square.

Sew the larger blue rectangle to the top of the pink square set.

Sew the pink square set to the top of the light blue strip.

Sew the blue background strip to the light blue strip so the pink rectangle touches the blue background fabric.

Top Section:

blue background
rectangle 58.75 X 13.75 finished.

Cut 2 width of fabric strips 14.25. Remove selvedges. Assuming the strips end up being 39-40 inches, cut about 1/3 off of one strip and assemble the other two pieces into a long rectangle. We are aiming for 58.75 inches, but a little extra will give us a little room later.

From the piece you cut off, cut a 5.5 inch strip across the scrap.
Cut that into an 8 X 5.5 inch rectangle and a 4.25 X 5.5 inch rectangle.
Cut a 3 inch square.

Sew the 3" blue square to the left side of the pink square that came with your fabric.
Sew the 4.25 X 5.5 inch rectangle to the bottom of the pink square set.
Sew the 8 X 5.5 inch rectangle to the top of the pink square set.
Sew the pink square set to the 58.5 inch rectangle so the pink square touches the big rectangle.
