



fabric for gold square

Gold:

- A: 1.25 X 2.5 finished so 1.75 X 3 cut
- B: 3.75 square finished so 4.25 cut
- C: 1.25 X 2.5 finished so 1.75 X 3 cut
- D: 36.25 X 6.25 finished so 36.75 X 6.75 cut
- E: 1.25 X 12.5 finished so 1.75 X 13 cut
- F: 23.75 X 7.5 finished so 24.25 X 8 cut
- G: 32.5 X 8.75 finished so 33 X 9.25 cut
- H: 32.5 X 7.5 finished so 33 X 8 cut

- G: Cut a width of fabric strip 9.25 inches wide. Remove the selvages. from one end of that strip cut a rectangle 33 inches long. (scrap 7x9.25)
- H: Cut a width of fabric strip 8 inches wide. Remove the selvages. from one end of that strip cut a rectangle 33 inches long. (scrap 7x8)
- F: Cut a width of fabric strip 8 inches wide. Remove the selvages. From one end of that strip cut a rectangle 24.25 inches long. (scrap 15x8)
- D: Cut a wof strip 6.75 inches wide. Remove the selvages. From one end, cut a strip 36.75 inches long. (5X6.75)
- E: From the scrap left over from F, cut a strip 13 X 1.75.
- A & C: Cut two rectangles 1.75 X 3.
- B: From any scrap, Cut a square 4.25".

Hello J [redacted],

Thank you for working on the Quiltcon 2017 Charity Challenge quilt! I really appreciate your willingness to work with my design and my directions.

The directions include: a list of pieces needed from each fabric, a set of cutting directions for each piece, and sewing directions.

"Wof" means selvedge to selvedge width of fabric.

When I write "finished" size that means the size of the rectangle or square without seam allowances. The directions for cutting should already have .5 inches added to each dimension. I write down both so I can double check my math as I cut things out.

I cut the fabric amounts for your kits at the last meeting and I really hope that I gave you the right amounts. I just had a rough estimate at the time. Let me know if you have and questions.

Yellow:

1.25 X 25 finished so 1.75 X 25.5 cut

Pink:

2.5 square finished so 3 square cut - this is in your kit already cut.

Blue: 45 inches

center: 22.5 X 25 finished so 23 X 25.5 cut

left: 40 X 2.5 finished so 40.5 X 3 cut

right: 40 X 21.25 finished so 40.5 X 21.75 cut

Cut wof strips 21.75 and 3" wide. I am hoping that these will be at least 40.5 after you remove the selvages.

Cut wof strip 25.5.

Cut a 23" piece for the center.

Turquoise:

1.25 X 25 finished so 1.75 X 25.5 cut

Sew the turquoise piece to the bottom of the center blue piece.

Sew gold piece F to the left side of the center pieces.

Sew gold piece G to the bottom of the center pieces.

Sew gold piece H to the right side of the center pieces.

Sew gold piece A to the left end of the yellow rectangle.

Sew gold piece E to the other end of the yellow rectangle.

Sew gold piece C to the left side of the pink square.

Sew gold piece B to the top of the pink square set.

Sew gold piece D to the right side of the pink square set.

Sew the A-yellow-E set to the top of the pink square set.

Sew all of this to the top of the rest of the gold square.

Sew the narrow blue strip to the left side of the gold square.

Sew the large blue rectangle to the right side of the gold square.
